PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

All parents and guardians are expected to act as mature adults at all times when associated with the Noblesville Hockey Club (NHC) program.

Any board member has the right to remove a NHC parent whose behavior they feel is socially unacceptable. If the parent does not then remove themselves from the rink, their respective player will be removed from the bench or the practice ice. The following behaviors will not be tolerated:

- Excessive verbal abuse of the officials.
- Physical abuse of an official.
- Verbal/physical abuse of players, coaches, parents (ours or theirs).
- Inappropriate language while in the arenas, team functions, etc.
- Parents in the locker room before or after a game (exceptions include delivery of equipment, etc.).
- Parents are encouraged to maintain open communication with the coaches. Any issues should be addressed with the coaches after a 24 hour 'cooling off' period.
- Parents will support the coaches---issues should be addressed in a non-confrontational manner at an appropriate time.
- Parents are expected to understand and support the "Players Code of Conduct" and "NHC General Rules."
